Virtuelco platform testing report

Purpose: Platform functionality check

Summary:

The testing report for the Virtuelco platform was developed after a practical training session with 9th-grade students in the E-commerce specialty.

A payroll accounting function, part of the platform’s newly introduced module, was used during the training. The session was organized in two steps: initially, students prepared monthly payroll summaries, and afterwards they entered employee details and processed payroll for the months of January and February.

Students worked individually to complete the calculations and then verified their results directly within the platform. The overall feedback on the documents generated was very positive, and the activities helped students effectively understand and apply payroll accounting concepts through real-world examples.
